These inspections will be carried out by the market manager/managers and/or representatives of the market at any time. I understand that the market does not carry any insurance policies to cover individual participants and that I assume responsibility for carrying such insurance. I also confirm that I have all necessary governmental (Fed, State & Local as applicable) permits to sell my products at the Fitchburg Center Farmers Market.
